

# Accessible Wales



Our **Community Inclusion Project** is a pioneering initiative established by Accessible Wales, South Wales premier Disability Consultancy. The **Community Inclusion Project** aims at improving the accessibility of community buildings in the project areas.

Accessible Wales is undertaking the Community Inclusion Project because we believe in the value of “community”. We recognise that organisations may want to become more accessible and are aware of access issues disabled people may encounter but not know where to go for help, we can offer that support!

To take part in the project you simply have to fill in a non-committal expression of interest form. Once the project commences each organisation will receive an access audit which will outline the current levels of accessibility to their building and suggest possible improvements that can be made. There is no obligation to make any alterations to your building as a result of this report; this is not legally binding. If you wish to make these changes, we can help!

Following on from that access audit the organisations will receive free disability related training for their staff/volunteers and staff/volunteers of the groups that use the building.

Each venue involved in this project will receive between £300 and £700 worth of access consultancy and training.
